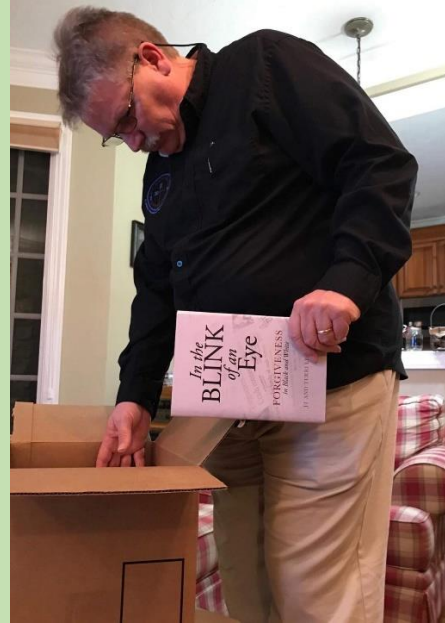


In the blink of an eye, tragedy can change lives without warning.

So was the case when J.T. Clark's and C.J. Martin's paths crossed nearly four years ago. Their lives have not been the same since.

On Friday, Aug. 21, 2015, Clark's brother and sister-in-law, Bobby and Pam Clark, were at a worship service at T.R.A.S.H. Ministries in Collinsville. Martin and his son were at a football game at Bassett High School. When both pairs left for home, they had to maneuver a detour on T.B. Stanley Highway. The Martins were in a pickup truck, and Bobby and Pam Clark were on motorcycles. Bobby and Pam Clark did not survive the accident. Instead of harboring hate for the other driver in the crash, Clark decided to forgive him and pay his court fines.
